

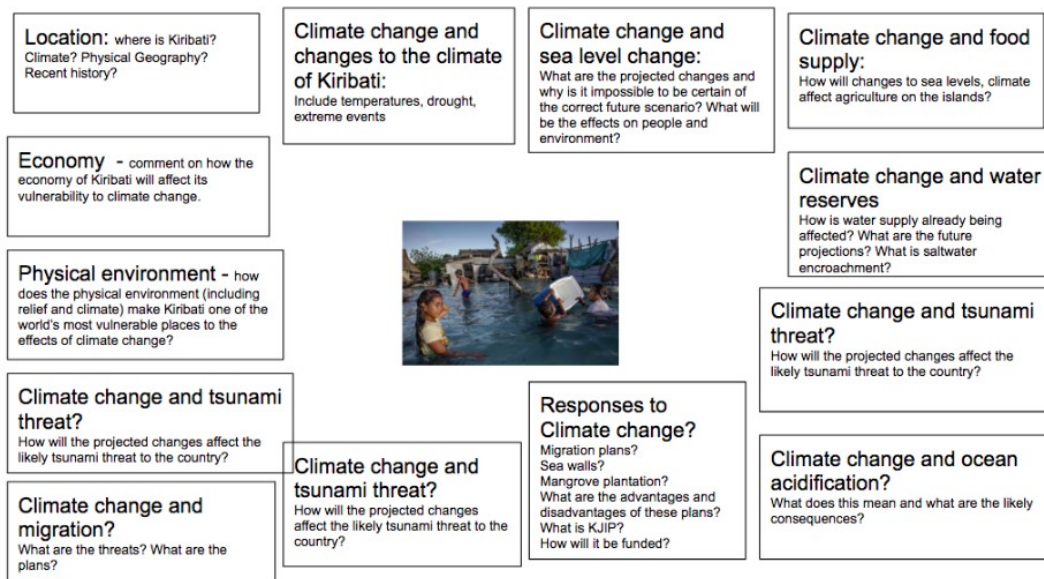
Kiribati – Case Study of Climate Migration
